More time allowed for Trilogy hearing

Cumberland residents will have more time and more on the line, now that a Trilogy public hearing scheduled for next week has been cancelled.

At a public meeting hosted by the Village this week on the Official Community Plan and zoning amendment applications for Trilogy's "remaining" lots — 2a, 2b, 3a, 3b, 3c, 5, 8a, 9a, 10a, 10b, 11 — it was announced that a hearing scheduled for next Thursday would be cancelled.

The decision was made to give the public more time with information brought forward on the development, said staff, and also to give negotiators time to finish a Comprehensive Development Agreement (CDA) for all of the 760-acres of Trilogy property around the village's interchange lands.

In the meantime, the lots that have already received third reading — lots 4, 6, 9b and 8 — will go back to second reading for a few small amendments, said Anja Nurvo, the village's chief administrative officer.

They hope the CDA will be finished in August, a document staff says will answer many questions regarding the large development. If the timing works out, a public hearing on the entire Trilogy project will be held in early September, although that isn't confirmed.
